Re: Data Genie Release - December 28, 2017

Members of the Rating Board:

I am pleased to inform you that on Thursday, December 28, 2017, the Rating Board's new data warehouse analytics tool, Data Genie, will be released. Data Genie is an IBM Cognos business intelligence tool-based application that provides data-driven insights into the New York State workers' compensation insurance marketplace, and will afford member insurers access to their own data and allow them to benchmark it against statewide results. The data in the application consists of both exposure and loss information from data reported on unit statistical reports and policies. Additional data sets will be added in the future.

With Data Genie, users will be able to design their own data and benchmarking reports, in both list and graphical form, and then download those reports to a variety of different applications, including Microsoft Excel. Data Genie will be outfitted with a pre-configured dashboard that is fully customizable to suit each user's specific needs and preferences. Further, several pre-programmed frequency and severity benchmarking reports will be available within the application. Additional features will be added to the application as they are developed in the near and long term.

To access the application on December 28, 2017 and thereafter, please visit the "Online Services" tab on our homepage, www.nycirb.org, and select Data Genie. Current users of the Rating Board's Premium-Loss-on-Demand application will be able to use their existing usernames and passwords to enjoy similar access and privileges in Data Genie. For those who are not current users, please contact Online Services at onlineservices@nycirb.org to create a new user account. The Premium-Loss-on-Demand application will be discontinued on January 31, 2018.

A live online training session for Data Genie will be provided at 1:00pm EST, on Tuesday, January 16, 2018. The session will be recorded and subsequently made available for viewing on the Rating Board's website. A Microsoft outlook meeting invitation will be sent to all current users of the Rating Board's Premium-Loss-on-Demand application.
