**Re: New York Workers Compensation  
Proof of Coverage Services**

The Rating Board is pleased to announce that, effective immediately, the Board will be accepting carrier policy information for transmittal to the New York Workers' Compensation Board (WCB), to comply with the new electronic reporting requirements established by the WCB.

The advantage to carriers of signing up with this service will be the elimination of the duplication of the submission of policy data to both the Rating Board and the WCB. The policy data which is submitted *electronically or via magnetic tape* to the Rating Board will be automatically sent in the appropriate format to the WCB if the carrier has been tagged by the Board's vendor as a carrier that has enlisted these services.

In order to become a subscriber to this service, please register with the Board's vendor, ISO ClaimPort, through the Internet at <http://wcis.iso.com> or call 1-800-888-4476.

The vendor's fee for this service is on a per transaction basis. Conversion of the standard electronic WCPOLS file to IAIABC POC format using ISO ClaimPort Transmitter is \$2.00 per policy transaction. Carriers who currently submit policy data in hardcopy format can also take advantage of this service by utilizing the ISO ClaimPort Online Reporter at a cost of \$3.00 per policy transaction.
