Re: 2022 Subscriptions to the Experience Modification Service (NY MODS)

Members of the Rating Board and Stakeholders:

I write to provide you with 2022 subscription information for the experience modification service for non-members of the Rating Board (*e.g.*, brokers, agents) (“NY Mods”).

By way of brief background, NY Mods provides non-members with the ability to access New York State employers’ experience modification and merit rating factors. Other information, such as classification, issue date, and effective date, is also available for review on the selected record. Insurer members of the Rating Board can access this information via the Rating Board’s Manage Data application.

Beginning in the spring of 2022, non-member subscribers to the NY Mods application will also be provided with a user profile for the Rating Board’s Mod Estimator application, which will enable them to save their work.¹ All insurer members of the Rating Board will be provided with user profiles for the Mod Estimator application and need not take any action at this time. Detailed information related to the Mod Estimator application will be provided closer to the product’s release date in the spring of 2022.

Non-members of the Rating Board who wish to access NY Mods in the 2022 calendar year must register for the NY Mods application or renew their subscription. The 2022 NY Mods subscription fee is \$2,100 for an account profile that can be utilized by all staff within a subscribing company. The subscription fee is non-refundable and will not be pro-rated for mid-year subscribers. Please note that current subscribers will be able to retain their user-id and passwords.
